For 25 years, WSPA has aimed to promote the concept of animal welfare in regions of the world where there are few, if any, measures to protect animals. With consultative status at the UN and the Council of Europe WSPA is active in more than 50 countries and has hundreds of thousands of supporters worldwide.

Politically, WSPA campaigns to convince governments and key decision makers to change practices and introduce new laws to protect or improve the welfare of animals.

This role's primary aim is to see the importance of farm animal welfare included in the position statements of key countries in the Asia Pacific Region going into the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development in 2012 and beyond. Responsibilities include building key relationships with governments and key stakeholders working on Rio+20 and assisting regional staff in their campaigning and lobbying efforts around the Asia Pacific region.
